Working with classroom teachers, parents and students is their major priority.

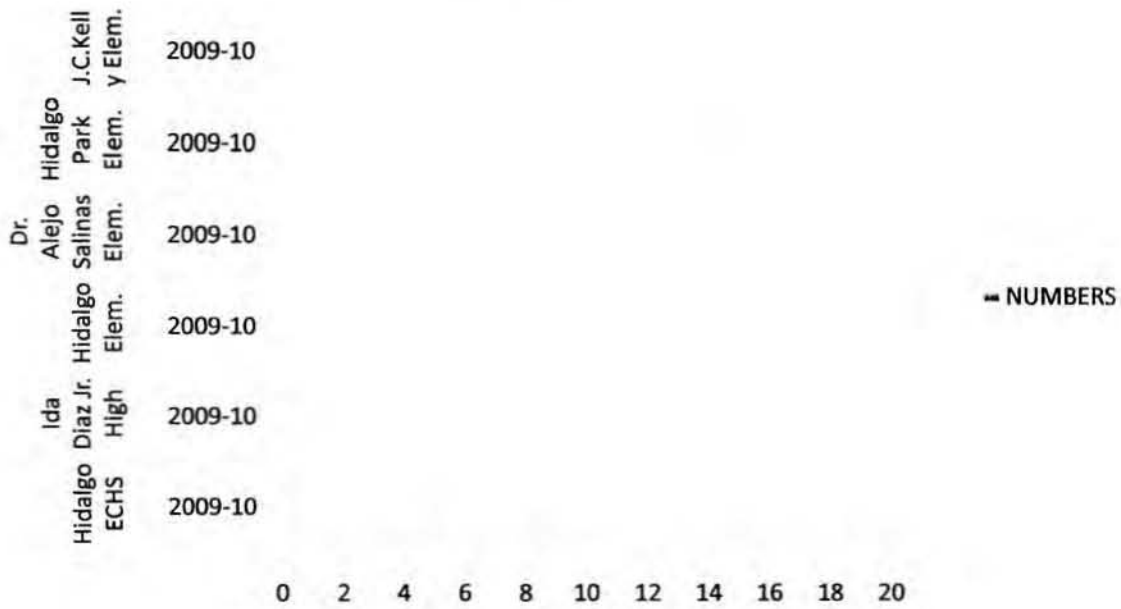
